

The SIG Young children's perspectives SIG has been active as usual this year.

- In March 2011 we published an edited book with Routledge. Edited by Harcourt, D., Perry, B. & Waller, T. *Young children's perspectives: Ethics, theory and research*. Routledge: London. The book has contributions from approximately 17 SIG members.
- In September a special issue of the EECERJ focusing on children's perspectives and participation in research was published, edited by Deborah Harcourt and Johanna Einarsdottir with contributions from approximately 12 SIG members.
- Following the 2011 EECERA conference in Geneva, the SIG held a symposium in Verona, hosted by the University of Verona. 11 SIG members attended.
- Two special issues of the International Journal of Early Years are now in preparation. One will be published in December this year and a further issue early 2013. Almost 20 SIG members will contribute.
- Members of the group are participating on a wide range of collaborative projects and presenting their research at international conferences.
