Activity 2013/14

The SIG group met at the EECERA conference in 2014 in Crete where we had a lively debate about research with families and how to support early years practitioners to engage with and work in partnership with parents and families.

The following ideas were discussed:

- setting up a Facebook page Joanne to co ordinate
- circulate presentations and papers from EECERA and other work that you would like to share on the Facebook page
- circulate notifications of any conferences/events that might be interesting to the group
- putting ideas together for joint publication in an EECERA monograph series Ute to co ordinate
