# EECERA ELECTORAL STRUCTURE



#### PREVIOUS CONFERENCE CHAIRS

- May join the Electoral College
- Must be formally registered as members of EECERA

## PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT & EDITOR

- Elected by the Board of Trustees by ballot every three years
- Reports to Trustees annually and to AGM
- May be re-elected

# THE ELECTORAL COLLEGE

- All former and current members of the Board of Trustees
- All former Conference chairs
- All Convenors of SIGs of 2 years standing
  - Must be current members of EECERA
  - Must formally register as a member of the Electoral College on an annual basis
- ⇒ Elects Trustees to Board of Trustees

### THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

- A maximum of nine Trustees including the Members' Trustee - meet twice a year: at Annual Board Meeting & at Conference
- Trustees report annually on their role and activity to the Members' AGM at Conference and to the Board at Annual Board Meeting
- Trustees are elected for 3 years by the Electoral College
- Exceptionally, by direct vote of the Board of Trustees, members may be co-opted for shorter periods from the current Membership or the Electoral College
- > Trustees may be re-elected or re-appointed
- > All Trustees are current EECERA members

#### CONVENORS OF EECERA SIGS

- May join the Electoral College
- Must have been active as SIG Convenor during 2 years
- Must be formally registered as members of EECERA

#### **MEMBERS**

- Are formally registered as EECERA members
- Can become part of the Electoral College as Conference Chairs, Convenors of SIGs or as a Members' Trustee
- Exceptionally, members can be co-opted directly to the BoT for short periods and specific assignments
- → Members elect a Members' Trustee every 3 years at the Conference Annual General Meeting

### MEMBERS' TRUSTEE

- MT is elected to Board of Trustees every three years by EECERA Membership competitive ballot at Conference AGM
- MT reports annually to Trustees and Members
- May be re-elected
